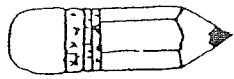

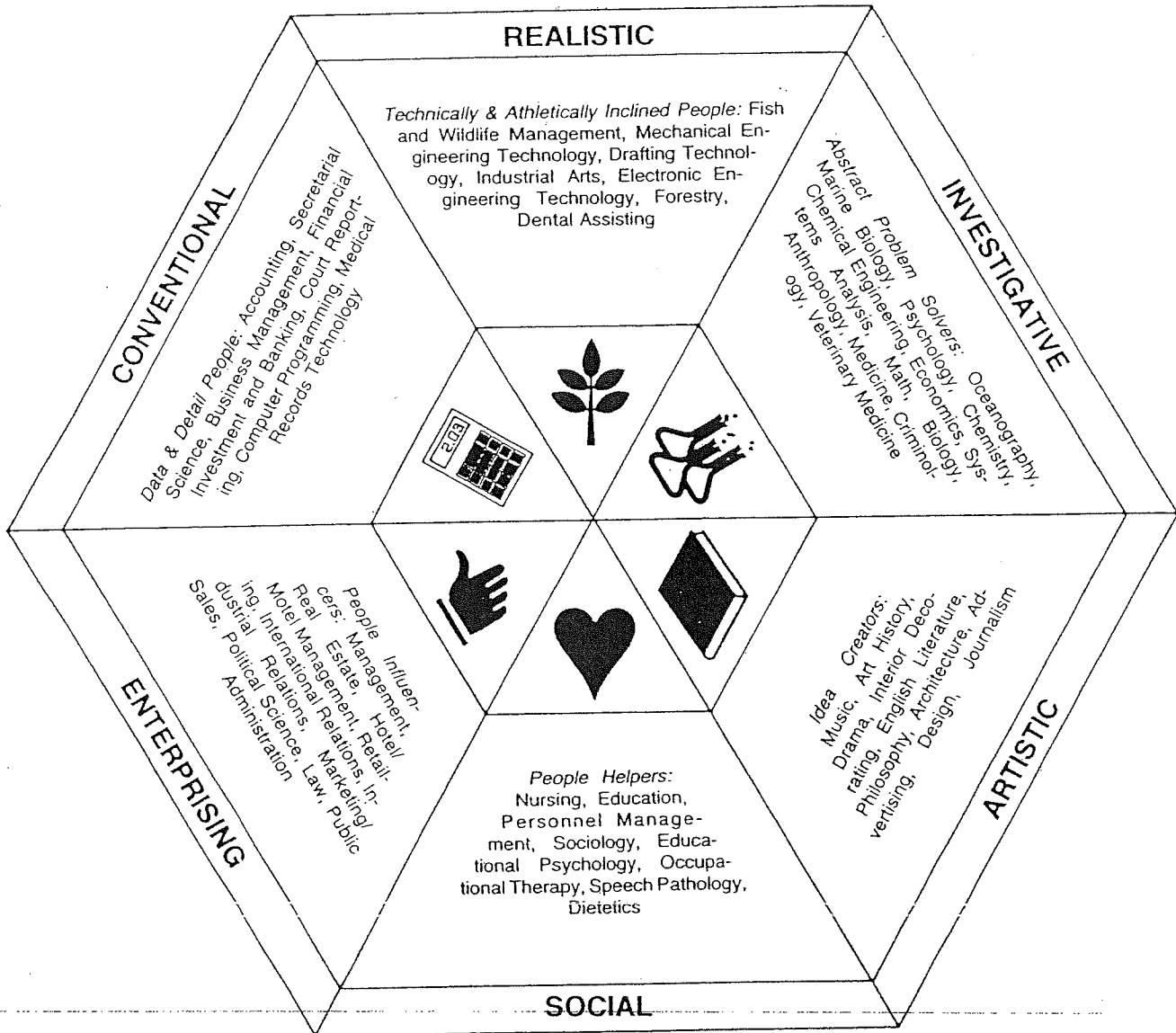


Figure 8. Occupational Groups

4 Use of Occupational Codes in Informational Interviewing*

An important step in career development is informational interviewing in which you interview workers to gather information about their work. Your Occupational Code can help you ask questions which are related to your interests. For instance, if you are high in Artistic interests, you will want to find out if a work environment will give you the flexibility you desire. On the other hand, a Conventional type will seek a structured environment.

If you are a REALISTIC type, you may want to ask your contact

- Are there tangible goals to work for, will I see a concrete result when a project is done?
- Is it possible to work independently, or are projects run by groups?
- Does this job produce a practical, useful product or service?
- Are there clear lines of responsibility?
- Will I be working with tools or machinery?

If you are an INVESTIGATIVE type, you may want to ask your contact

- How flexible is this position, how structured is this environment?
- Will I be free to pursue projects independently?
- Will I be able to exercise my writing/researching/analyzing skills?
- Will I be able to learn new skills?
- Will I be challenged intellectually?

If you are an ARTISTIC type, you may want to ask your contact

- Will I have the opportunity to be imaginative, creative, inventive, curious?
- Is the environment flexible?
- Will I be able to pursue projects independently?
- Will I have time for consideration or contemplation?

If you are a SOCIAL type, you may want to ask your contact

- Is there an emphasis on group work and social interaction?
- Will I be helping people by training, teaching, guiding, or mentoring?
- Will I be able to share my feelings and intuitions as well as my responsibilities?
- Does this position advance ethical, humanistic goals?

If you are an ENTERPRISING type, you may want to ask your contact

- Does this position have a good possibility of advancement?
- Will I be able to assume a leadership role?
- Will there be an opportunity to exercise my skills in speaking, selling, or persuading?
- Is this a dynamic, competitive work environment?
- Will I be able to use business skills such as negotiating?

If you are a CONVENTIONAL type, you may want to ask your contact

- Is the environment well organized, and efficient?
- Are the lines of responsibility clear?
- Will I be able to use office machinery to be more productive?
- Will I be able to exercise my own judgment and control my schedule?
- Are the hours regular and the duties consistent?

What Your Summary Code Means

Your Summary Code is a simple way of organizing information about people and jobs. It can be used to discover how your special pattern of interests, self-estimates, and competencies resembles the patterns of interests and competencies that many occupations demand. In this way, your Summary Code locates suitable groups of occupations for you to consider.

It is vital that you search The Occupations Finder for every possible ordering of your three-letter code. For example, if you are an **ESC**, search for all the **ESC**, **ECS**, **SEC**, **SCE**, **CES**, and **CSE** occupations by completing Steps 1 and 2.

Step 1. Find the occupations whose codes are *identical* with yours and list those occupations that are of interest to you. If your code is **SEI**, occupations with codes **SEI** are identical. Go to Step 2, whether or not you find an occupation with a code identical to yours.

Instructions for Using The Occupations Finder

The 1,334 occupations in this classification include all of the most common occupations in the United States. They are arranged in a system that uses the code letters **R, I, A, S, E, C**.

Realistic occupations (R) include skilled trades, technical occupations, and some service occupations.

Investigative occupations (I) include scientific occupations and some technical occupations.

Artistic occupations (A) include artistic, musical, and literary occupations.

Social occupations (S) include educational and social service occupations.

Enterprising occupations (E) include managerial and sales occupations.

Conventional occupations (C) include office and clerical occupations.

Codes: The three-letter Summary Codes provide descriptions of occupations. For example, the code of ESC for Business Manager means that business managers resemble people in Enterprising occupations most of all, that they resemble people in Social occupations somewhat less, and that they resemble people in Conventional occupations still less. In this way, the codes provide a brief summary of what an occupation is like by showing its degrees of resemblance to three occupational groups.

After exploring the occupations under your three-letter code, rearrange your code letters in all possible ways and explore occupations under those three-letter codes. For example, if your code is IRE, explore occupations under IRE as well as occupations under IER, RIE, REI, EIR, and ERI. If this strategy isn't helpful, see a career counselor for more information.

Education Levels: The single-digit number under "ED" indicates the level of education an occupation requires. These levels are only estimates and should not be regarded as precise requirements. The education levels are as follows:
